This collection challenges notions that amateur theatre is solely a phenomenon of the pre-professional past. 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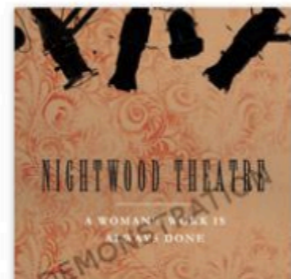
