As with other traditional etno-conessional groups, for the Sephardic Jews until the Holocaust, the primary branch of parody was the Parodia sacra. Given the Hebrew-centric nature of Jewish sacred literature, it is not surprising that the Passover Haggada, as one of the few liturgical texts performed in its entirety in Hebrew-Spanish, to ensure the participation of women and children in the central annual house ceremony, became a favorite hypotek of Sephardic parodists. Today, about a hundred Passover parodies in the Hebrew-Spanish language are known. Most of them were created during the second half of the 19th and the first half of the 20th century, primarily in the Balkans, but also in Tel Aviv, New York, Kurasau, and Vienna. One of the most unusual Sephardic Passover satires is the "Partisan Agada" by Šalom Šani Altarac, created on the free Yugoslav territory, in Kordun, Lika and Banija in 1944. 

Social networking sites may be useful for researchers but they can't replace institutional repositories.

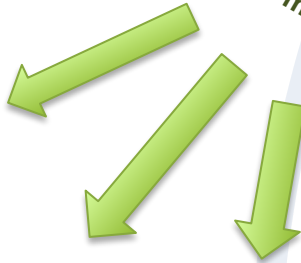

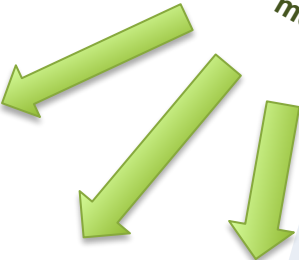

Tricky issues: “I promised to Elsevier I won’t make my work available to anyone.”

- Go to the journal’s website, read, analyze, and explain the self-archiving policy (in front of the audience).
- Show the relevant record in Sherpa Romeo
- Explain that the authors are safe because the repository manager checks every single deposit.

Takeaways for researchers

- The institutional repository is an infrastructure owned by you.
- The institutional repository is curated: Someone is taking care, and you know this person!
- The repository is here to stay.
- Forget about small languages and “national” topics. All research outputs are potentially interesting to an international audience, but they have to be discoverable.
- The repository increases the visibility of your research even better than social networking sites for researchers.
- Content diversity is desirable.
